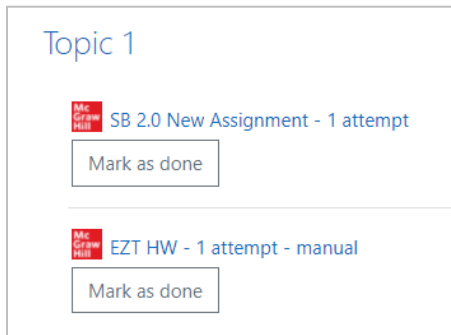


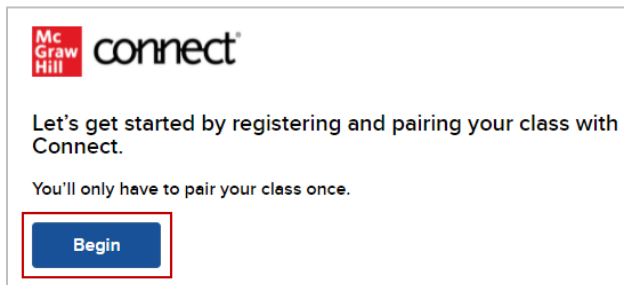
Moodle LTI Advantage Integration – Student Workflow

Student Registration

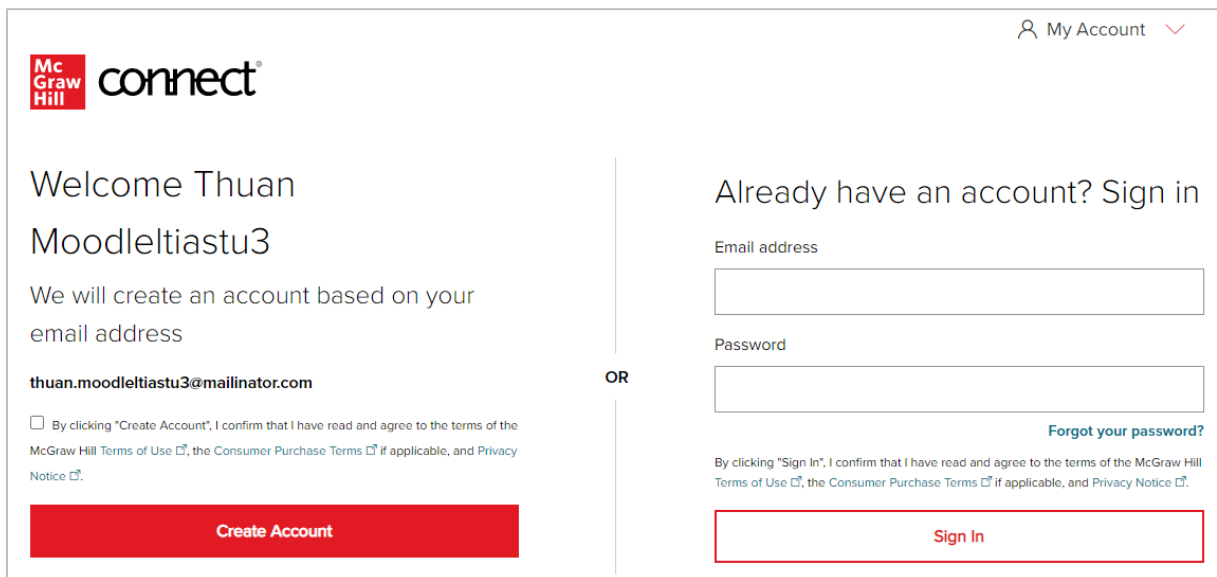
1. Log into Moodle and navigate to your course
2. Navigate to a Connect assignment and click on it




3. Click **Begin**



4. **Sign In** with an existing Connect account or **Create Account**




5. You have three registration options.
 - a. Connect Code: Enter a Connect access code and click **Redeem**
 - b. Purchase Online: Click **Buy It** to use a credit card
 - c. Temporary Access: Click **Access Now** for two-week temporary access
