Refunds And The Reconciliation Report

To view funds on the Reconciliation Report you will want to run a detailed version for the needed date range. This version will give you a breakdown of all the gifts that day (listed in black) and all the refunds (listed in red). The totals for each batch are a net of the gifts and refunds, but they may not appear that way on your bank statement. ACH deposits, for example, will separate these two items and you will need to view the detailed report to identify the individual amounts.
