



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Introducing Source-Nexus Control Panel

Source Nexus Control Panel is a virtual audio device manager for Mac OSX, allowing you to create named virtual audio devices with multiple channels.



The possibilities are endless: opens an entire new world for application integration with Pro audio users and their studio environment.

You can patch in any software such as phone applications, metering, encoders, decoders, external processors, other audio workstations, video editors, even a browser web page! With up to 24 channels, and with multiple devices and channels there is no limit to application routing.

Extreme flexibility for Input and Output separation means you can connect all your Audio apps for monitoring, recording and effects however you want them.

Why do I need Source-Nexus Control Panel?

Virtual drivers allow you to route audio between applications without needing external hardware or cables. Used in conjunction with the companion Source-Nexus plugins you can route any audio to, and from, your favorite DAW.

Creating Devices

In order to create new devices:


- 1. Click on the + button to create a new device.
- 2. Enter a device name. E.g., "My Device"
- 3. Choose a number of channels.



Deleting Devices

In order to delete devices:

- 1. Open the Source-Nexus Control Panel application.
- 2. In the "Devices" list, select the device you want to delete.
- 3. Click on the X and it will be immediately deleted.
