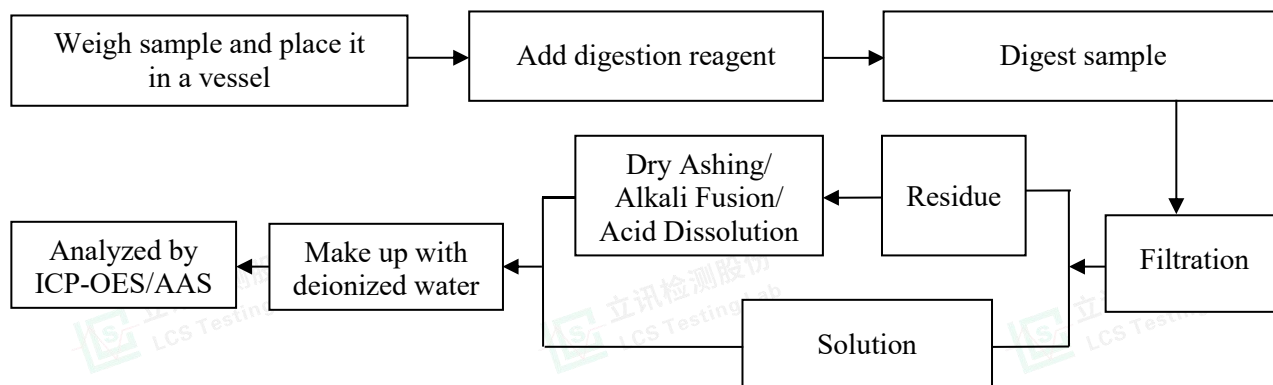

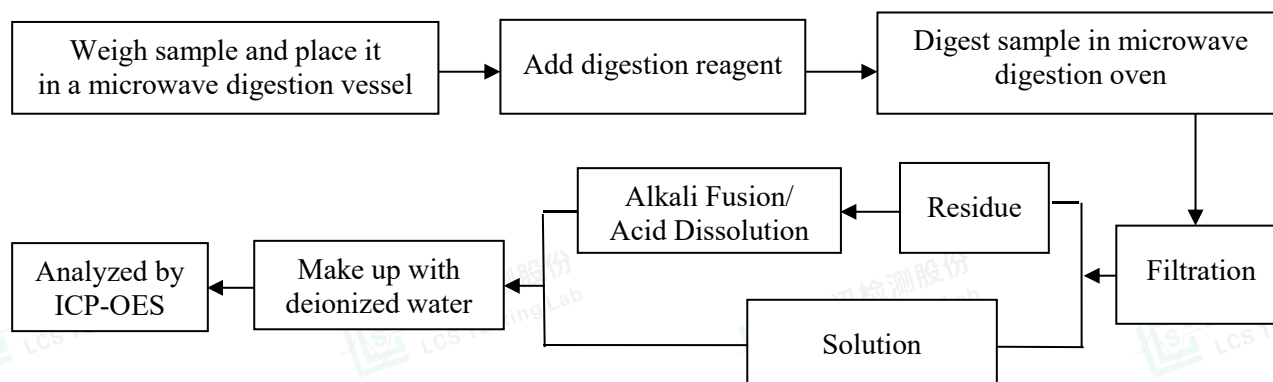

1. Lead(Pb) & Cadmium(Cd): IEC 62321-5:2013

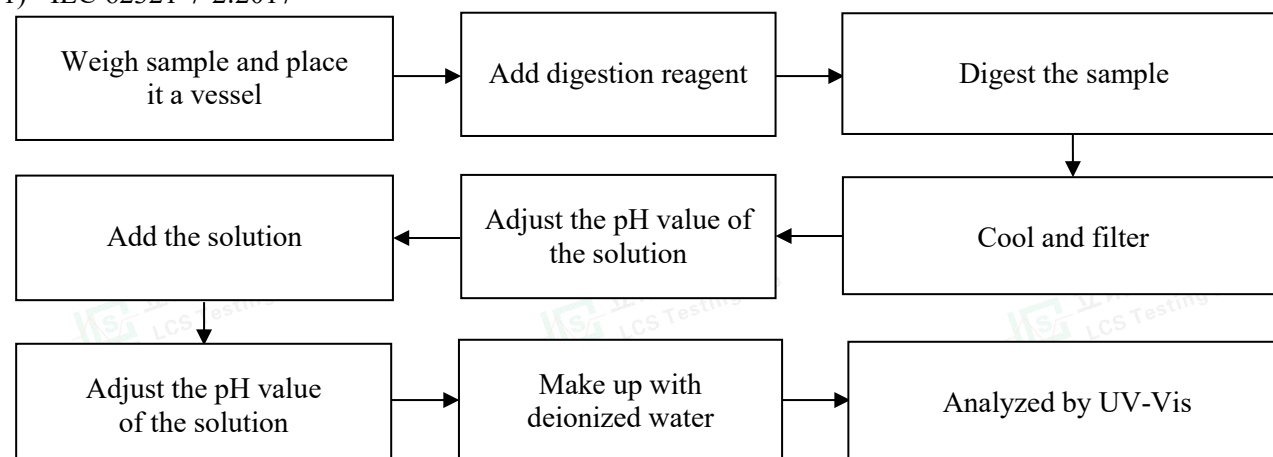


2. Mercury(Hg): IEC 62321-4:2013+AMD1:2017 CSV



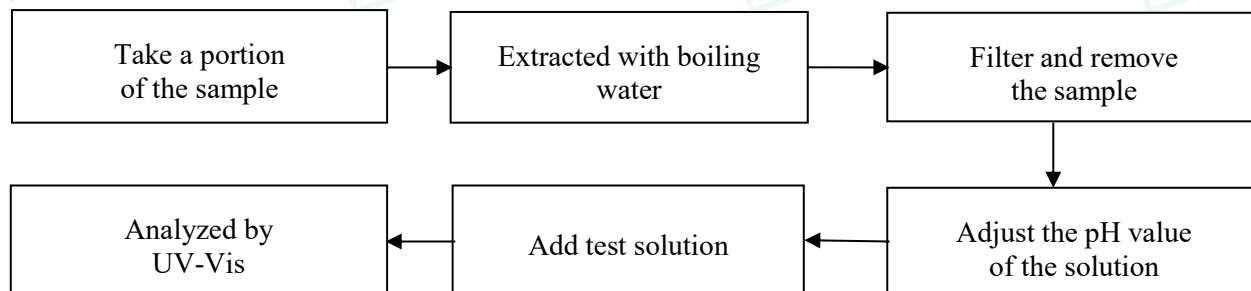
