Design Process Overview

When you select one of the custom design options below, we will provide up to three iterations to deliver a polished, professional journal design:

- **First iteration:** Consulting Services works with our design and technical teams to create a mock-up image based on the information you provide with this form. The design team may ask for additional information before preparing the first iteration.
- **Second iteration:** Once you receive your first mock-up, you may want to make changes or provide feedback to hone the design. The design team will incorporate these requests into your second mock-up.
- **Third iteration:** If further changes are necessary, you may request a third iteration. Once this is complete, you may choose from any of the iterations for your final design.
- **Approved design:** When you approve the design, it is considered finalized and applied to a demo site. Please check with stakeholders before approving a mock-up. **Changes requested after the finalized design may incur fees and/or delay the launch of your journal.** If you have questions about this, please contact Consulting Services.
