Flip your video in the Call Screen

Video Call participants can flip their local video feed horizontally during a Video Call, if desired. The self-view screen in a Video Call is designed to mirror the image by default. Flipping the local feed can be useful for things such as completing physiotherapy exercises, or having a non-mirrored view of a specialised scope device.

This image shows a sideby-side view of a default and a flipped local video feed, after pressing the highlighted **flip video** button.




Resource Centre:

Compatible medical devices

We have added information to our Resource Centre regarding the use of **Visionflex** specialised telehealth devices, including cameras, scopes and video glasses, with healthdirect Video Call. The Visionflex devices can enrich telehealth consultations by enabling remote examinations. Example use of the devices may include examination of the patient's skin, eyes, mouth and throat.

Interoperable devices and use case examples are detailed here.
