









Charge book organizers 3 NATIONS CUP 2024

General rules

The UCI regulations, Part VI BMX, particular title 6, Racing regulations BMX, in the last published edition, are applicable to the 3 nations cup.

Races 2024

In 2024, the races will be held on the following days and locations:

Ahnatal (D): 28. June – 30. June 2024

Peer (B): 30. August – 1. September 2024

Uithoorn (NL): 20. September – 22. September 2024

On Saturday, only riders with a Belgian, German or Dutch racing license can register. On Sunday, the race is classified as C1, and registration categories will take place according to the regulations of the UCI.

Registration on Sunday

All riders are able to register themselves on the Sunday race (double fees apply). Junior and elite riders with a license by the Belgium, German or Dutch Federation are allowed to register themselves on Sunday for the Sunday race (double fees apply).

The above-mentioned numbers apply per day and per category.

The cost for the numberplates will be charged to the organizer (approximately 1600 €).

The cost for the fotofinish will be charged to the organizer (655 € + travel costs)

Prizes

The organizer shall bear the cost for the trophies in the challenge categories as follows:

Challenge categories Boys and girls 8- until 15/16: All riders in the finals: 1 trophy per category per race. (2 races in the weekend). There is an additional price money for place 1-3 in category Boys and Girls 15/16. Challenge categories Cruisers/ Men 17+/ Women 17+ and over: All riders in the finals: 1 trophy per category per race. (1 race in the weekend)











The organizer shall bear the cost of the cash prizes for the four championship classes (Men and Women Elite, Men and Women U23, Men and Women Junior) + category 15/16 (only Sunday)

If less than 9 riders participate in a race, the prize money will be reduced with 20%. (UCI Financial Obligations BMX 2024 Page 10)

At the last race in Uithoorn, for all classes the numbers 1, 2 and 3 earn a medal of the competition of 3 or 6 races. These medals are for the account of the federation of Belgium, Germany and The Netherlands. The 3-Nations Organisation-Commission must arrange the prizing ceremony for these competition medals and the additional price money for 1-3 in category 15/16 boys and girls.

In case we have to cancel 1 or more races, there is no prizing ceremony at the last competition!

Personnel, officials etc.

All personnel directly or indirectly concerned with the race must be provided with special ID cards. The organizer must provide ID cards / passes to:

- UCI appointed PCP
- 10 ID's each for the National federations of Belgium, Germany and Holland
- Officials
- Members of the 3 Nations Commission (Carsten Rövenstrunk, Heike Rövenstrunk, Michel Vermeiren, Evert-Jan Haarhuis, KNWU-Representative, Peter Vaessen, Hans Seesing).

The organizer must be able to provide sufficient personnel of its own for catering services or must contract these services out to a catering company, so as to ensure that food and drinks are available without long waiting times. A special line / area should be dedicated for the working staff so that they are not mixed with the public.

The national cycling federation organizing the event is required to provide all the Commissaires as per UCI rule book. Regarding the National Commissaires and the Assistant PCP an agreement must be established with the National Federation.











One car with driver should be ready to shuttle UCI officials between airport, or railway station, hotel and track during the whole event.

The organizer must provide the officials as stipulated in the UCI BMX Rule book for the running of races and training sessions. The same applies to other personnel required during the event for safety or for care of the BMX track. All officials involved in the running of the races must be able to prove that they have received specific national or international training in the running and management of BMX races. These officials must be able to communicate in English language.

JSTiming Photo finish

Equipment BMX 3-Nations Cup will receive:

- High speed finish camera
- Finish line detection (auto recording finish line passages)
- Front-identification-camera (reading number plates)
- Backup finish-video-camera
- 2 reading stations
- All the equipment is equipped with UPS power backup
- At night-/ evening races LED finish line lights.
- DNS-tablet
- DNF-tablet
- Led board with race number, synchronized with the DNS tablet
- UCI-proved race software (included print equipment)

What do we expect from the organizer

- Jury room equipped with 230VAC 16A 50Hertz
- If a finish truss has been/will be placed, the finish truss must be placed just before or just behind the finish line
- Parking space for car/trailer (in finish area)
- Jury room with 5 (6 with PCP) workspaces in the vicinity of the finish area (max 15 meters)
- 3 local employees with basic computer knowledge
- Supply of printing paper (A4)
- Food and drinks in the jury room during the event
- 2 x 2 hotel rooms during the event (2 x 2 nights, Fri-Sat and Sat-Sun)
- As mentioned in the financial obligations, an expense allowance of 655, € = (six hundred- fifty-five euro) (ex VAT) per race day
- Registration -administration costs of €0.80 (ex VAT) per registration per race day
- Travel costs €0,35 KM (ex VAT)
- If applicable any other travel expenses (hotel, boat, airplane, toll)
- Guarding jury room / timing equipment / trailer (2 nights, Fri-Sat and Sat-Sun), in case of theft, the organization is liable.











Medical support

It is mandatory for a doctor to be present at trackside during the complete event (training sessions and competition) on Saturday and Sunday and he/she must be backed up by an adequate paramedical service with care and treatment facilities. The organisation shall follow the local rules concerning the medical support. All costs will be covered by the organizer.

Anti-doping Controls

The Organizer has to be prepared in case of any anti-doping controls organized by the CADF or local anti-doping agency during the event (anti-doping rooms in accordance with the UCI rules). The Organizer together with its National Federation will make agreements with an ITA accredited laboratory that will carry out the analysis at the end of the event. Moreover, in accordance with the UCI rules, the Organiser will purchase all the necessary material (Bereg Kits) with which the anti-doping controls will be carried out and supply the necessary staff, including a doctor, a nurse and the prescribed DCO for the duration of the event. All costs will be covered by the Organizer or local anti-doping agency.

Federation – local costs

All the costs from the National Federation and local costs such as permits etc. must be paid by the organizer.

Flags and Banners

During the races every organisation must show the flags of the 3 countries (Belgium, Germany and the Netherlands) Beachflags and Banners of the UCI 3-Nationcup must show also on each event of the Series! The organisation of the 3 Nations cup provides the Flags and Banners.

13 years and over: Saturday € 8,00, Sunday: € 10,00, passe-partout: € 15,00

5-12 years: Saturday € 5,00, Sunday: € 8,00, passe-partout: € 10,00

Camping (maximum)

Campervan and Camper: Weekend 90, - € incl. power supply, 45,- € without power supply

Tent: Weekend 30, - € with power supply, 15, - € without power supply
