

Using myViewBoard Whiteboard: Any time during a lesson, **hover over** a tool for quick feature tips.




Signing in

Sign in with your myViewBoard account to access full Whiteboard features and your personal settings.






Whiteboard provides a selection of styles and customizations to create and deliver class-leading content.

Pens:




Use pen tools to draw freehand lines, shapes, and more.

Text Editor:




Type, edit, and format text on the canvas.




OLF for cross-platform lessons: Save OLF files and open them across Whiteboard versions.




