# Program Administration (Structure)

Program structure is the 'overall' form of the program in which the enrolled students will need to fulfill in order to complete the program i.e. what forms a program?

As an example, a student who is enrolled into [Bachelor of Business Information Systems](#) will need to accomplish the following which totals up to 120 credits:

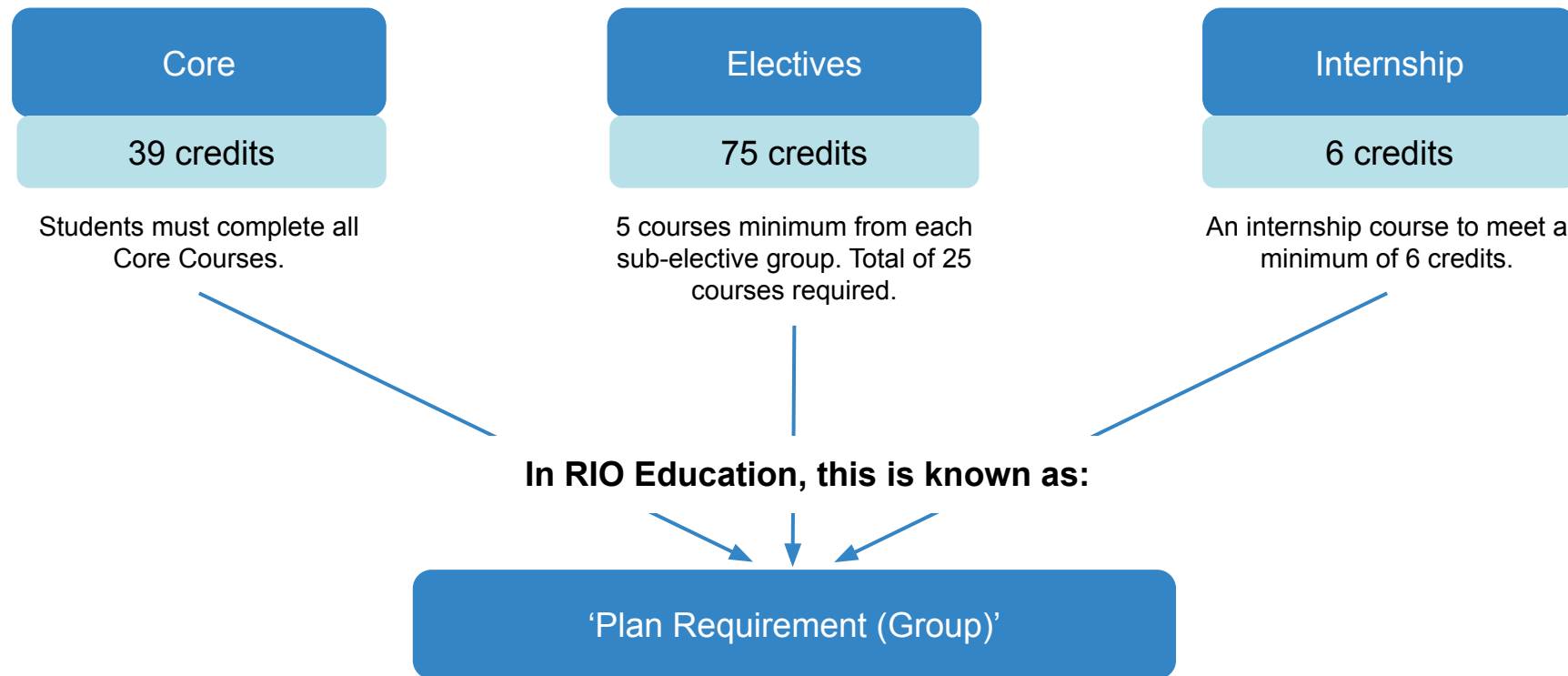
*Student's program structure under the Bachelor of Business Information System*

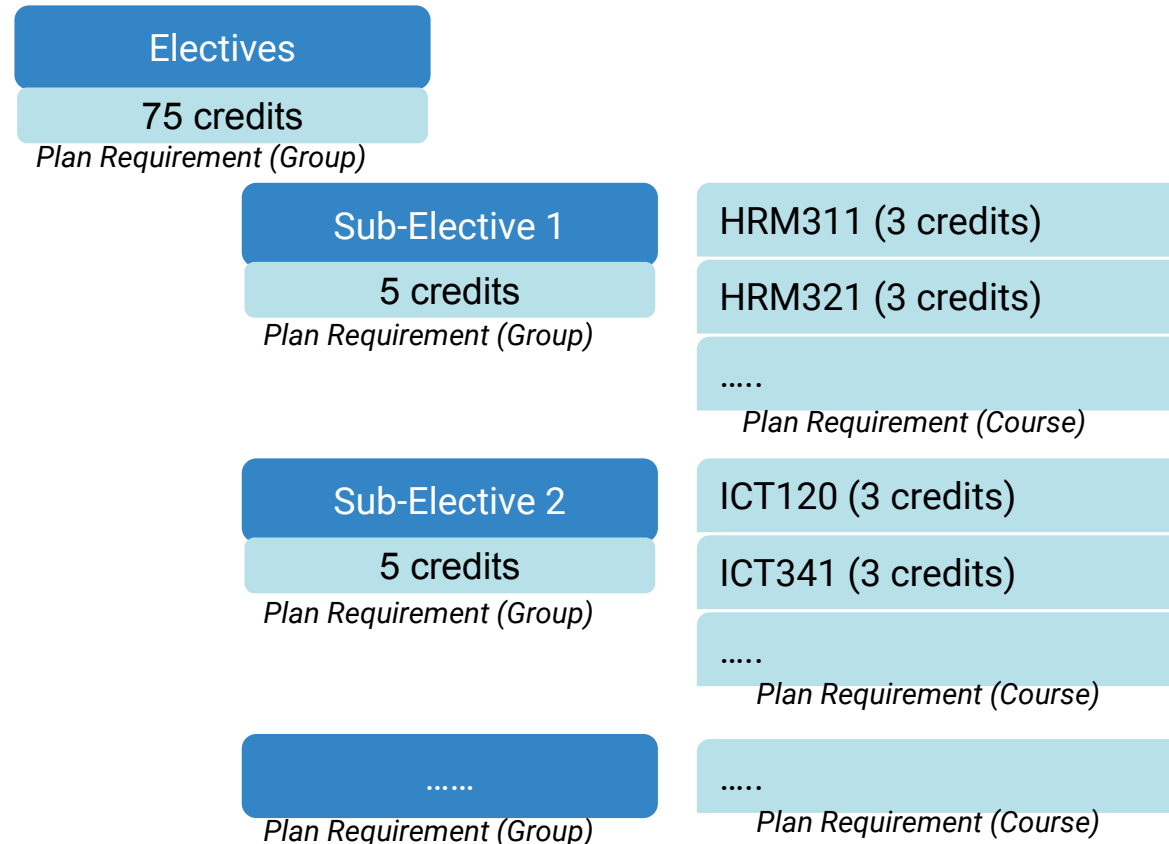
**In RIO Education, all Courses under a Plan Requirement (Group) are known as:**

'Plan Requirement (Course)'



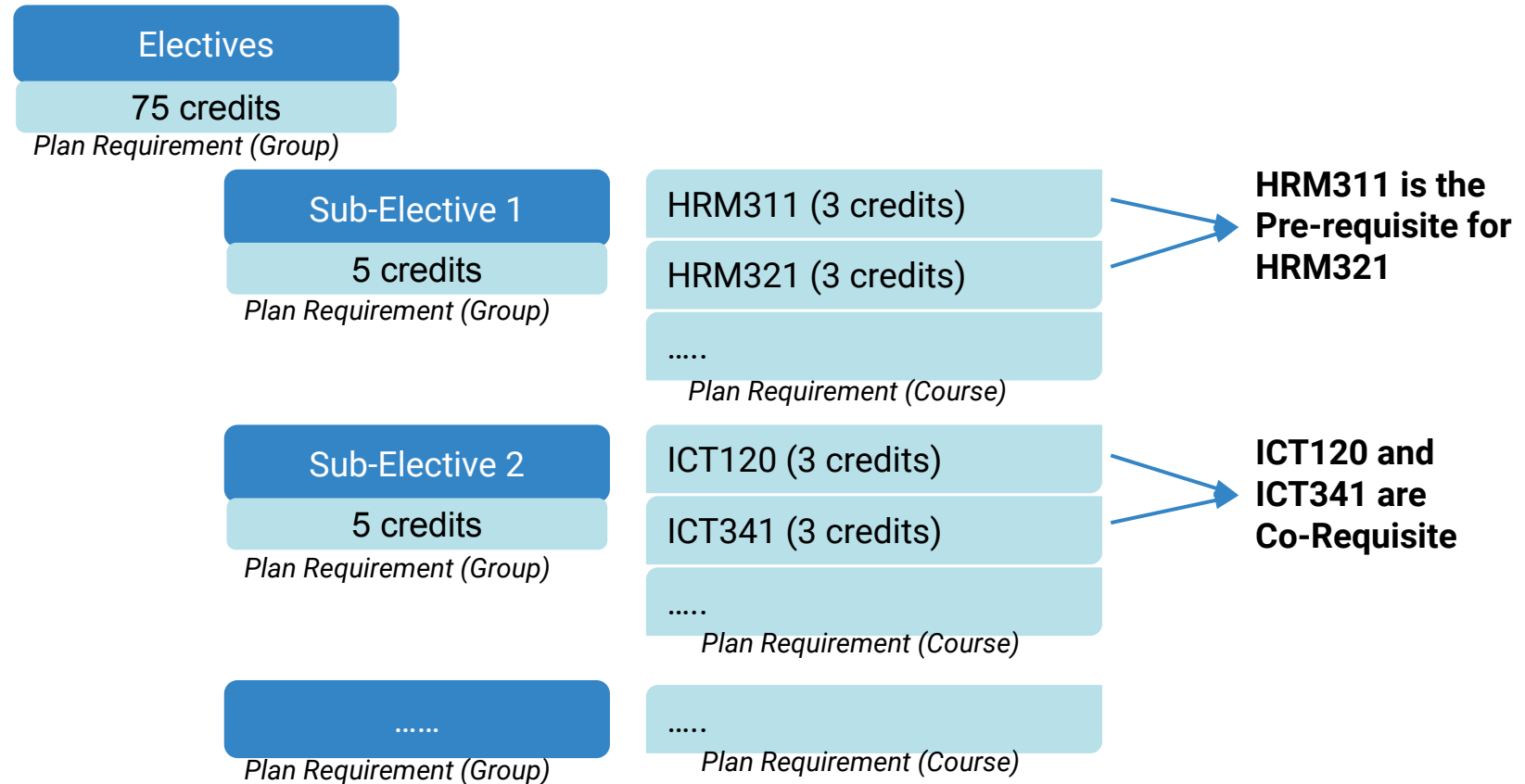
# Program Administration (Structure)

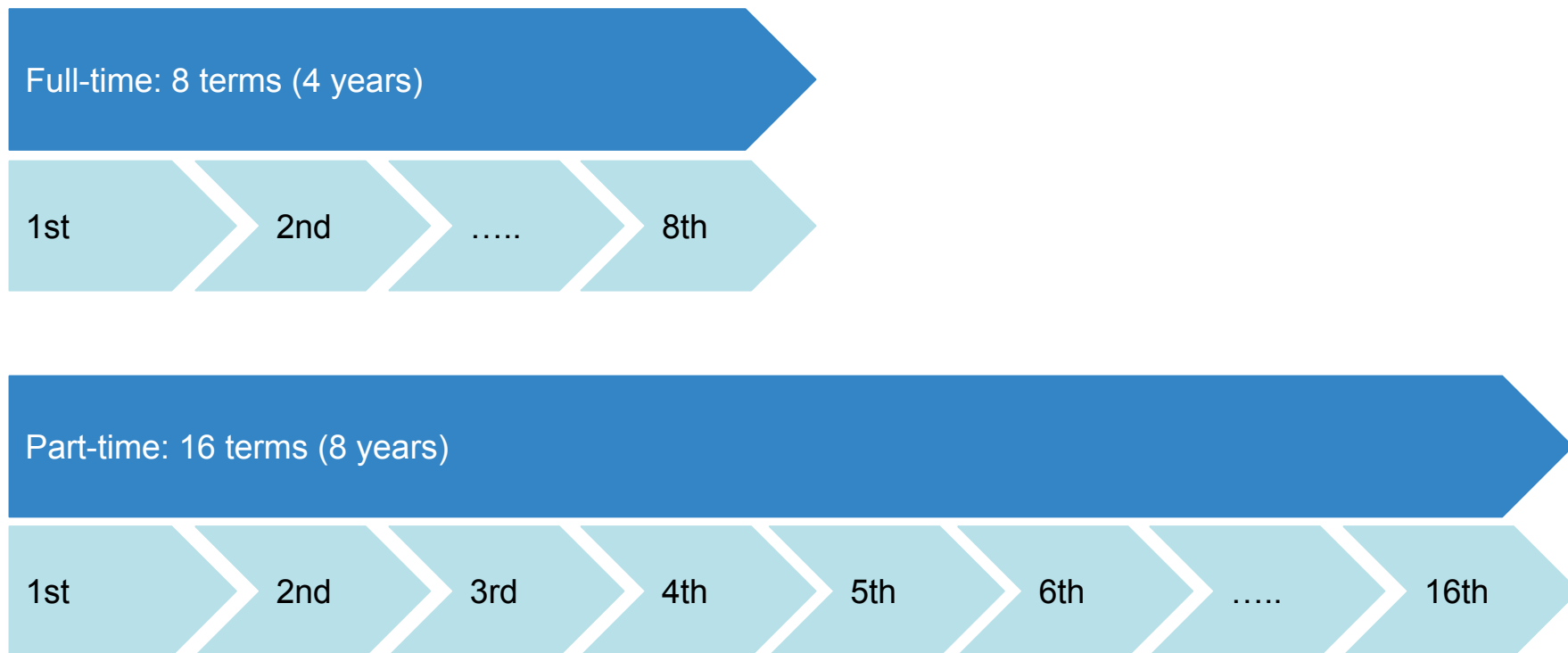
“There are many ways one can complete their Program. The Pathway constitutes or serves as the best track/approach recommended by the institution for the Student to complete their Program.”



# Program Administration (Pathway)

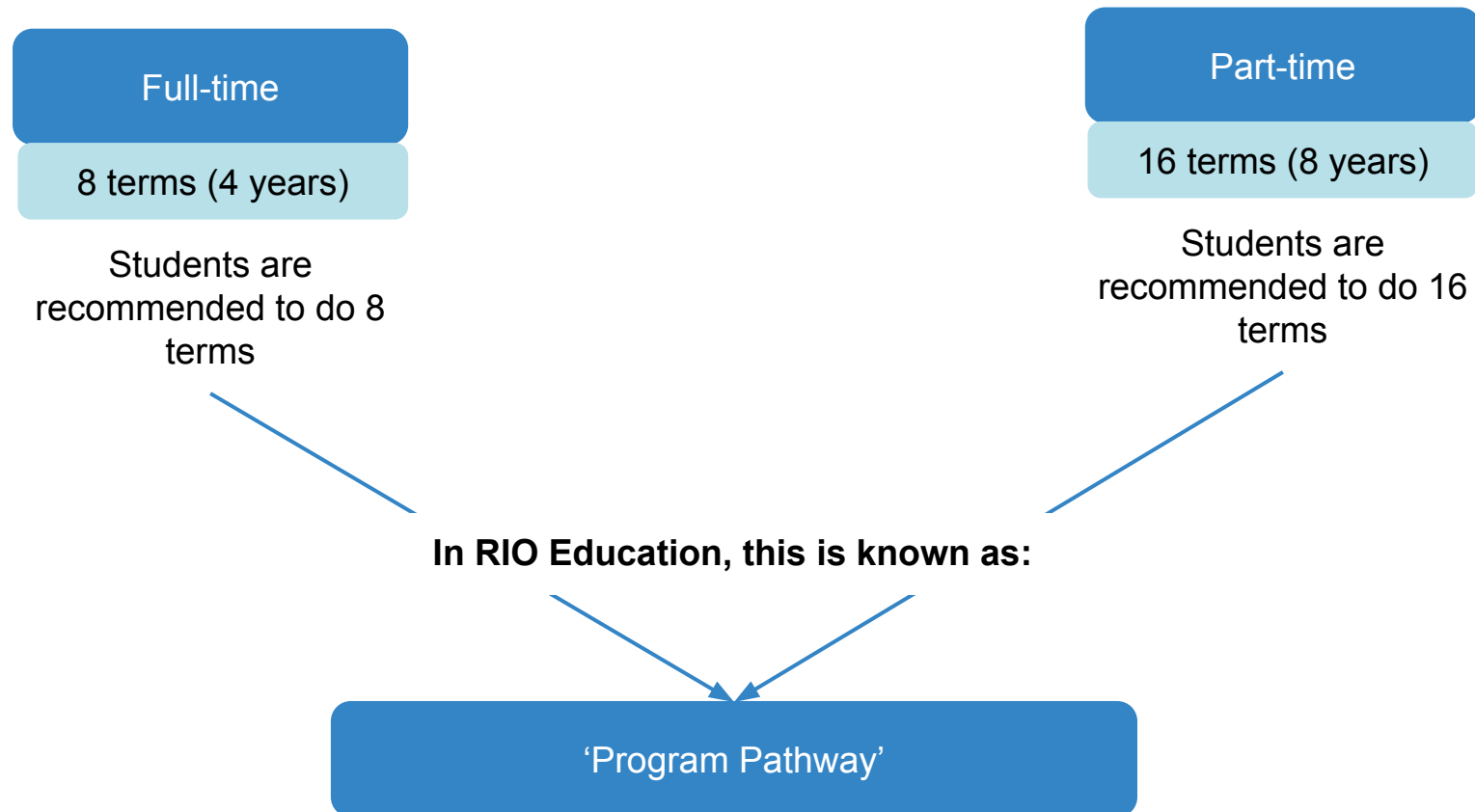
Program Pathway is a concept in RIO Education that refers to the 'recommended' path through a program.

As an example, for a program like a [Bachelor of Business Information System](#), there may be a full-time pathway that spans 8 Terms (4 years) or a part-time pathway that spans 16 Terms (8 years) or more.

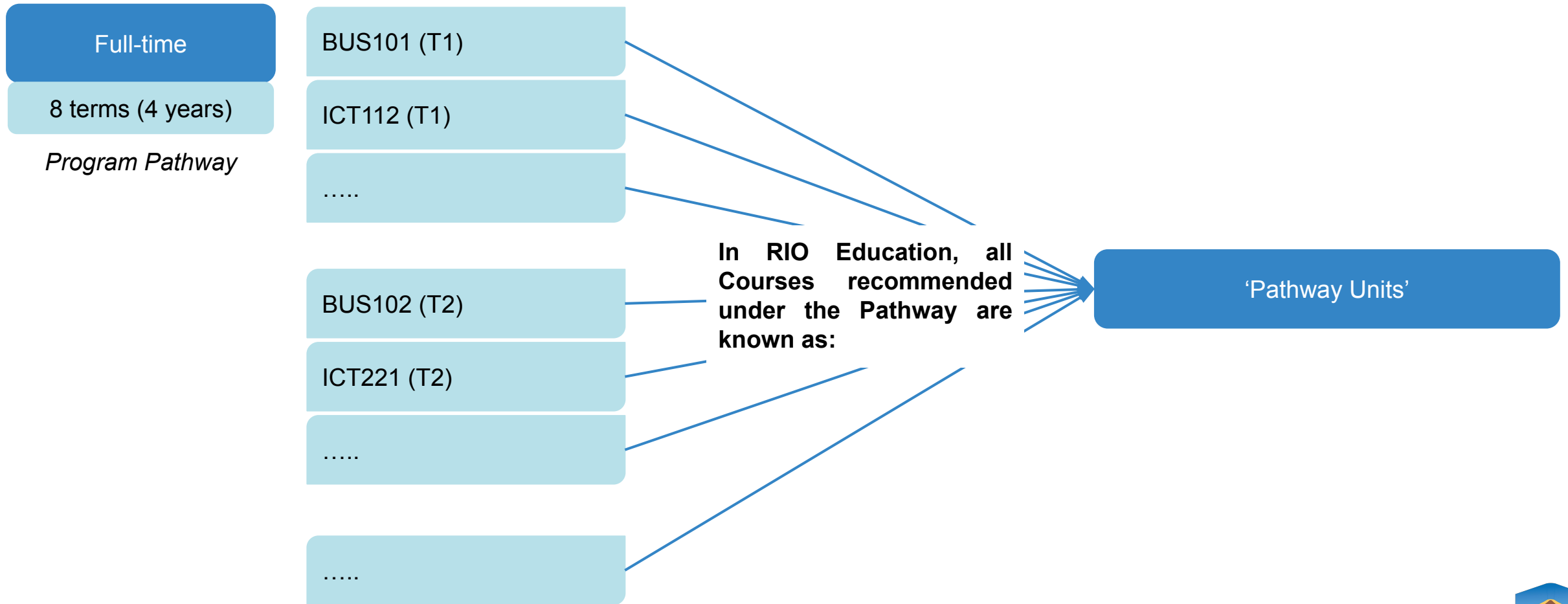


# Program Administration (Pathway)

Back to [Bachelor of Business Information Systems](#), there are 2 pathways for the student choose from. The recommendation is broken down to:

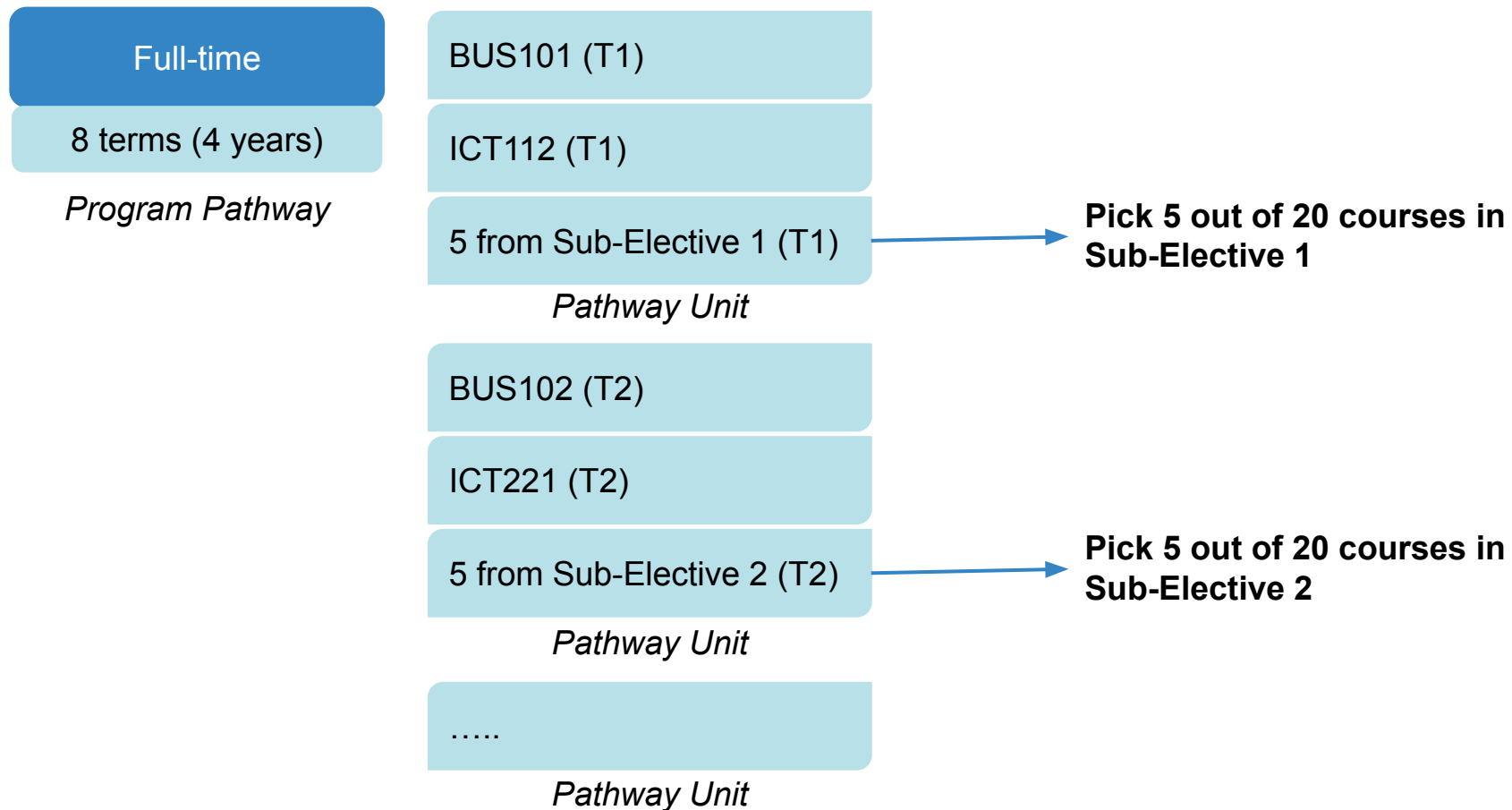

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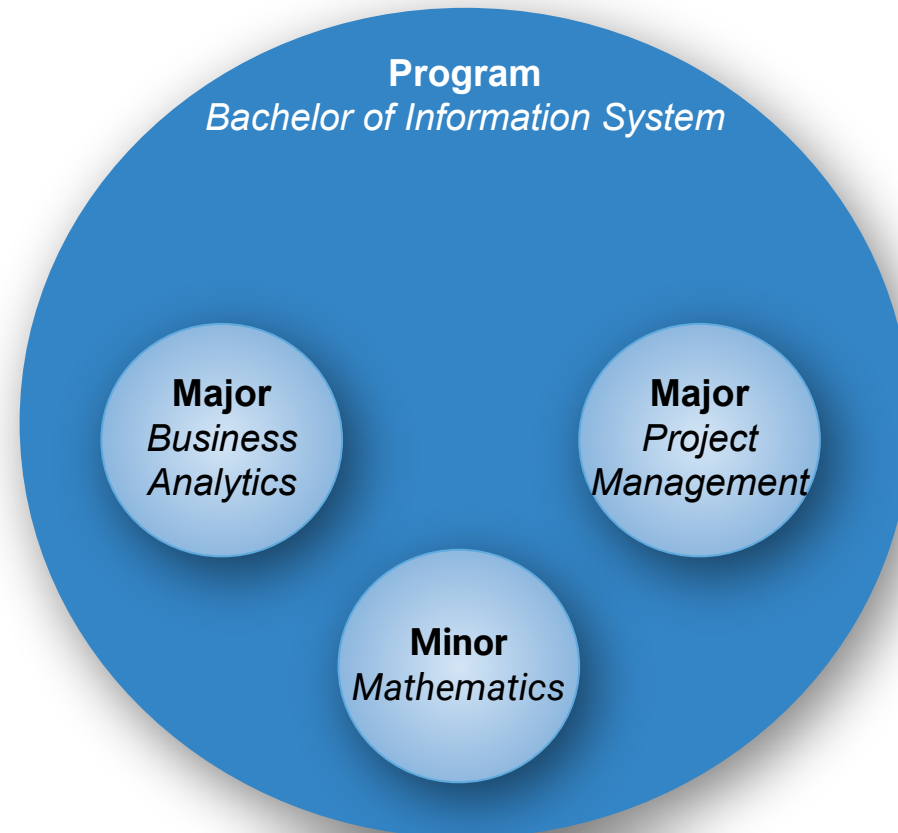

# Program Administration (Discipline)

Program Discipline is a concept in RIO Education that enables users to setup the corresponding majors/minors of a program.

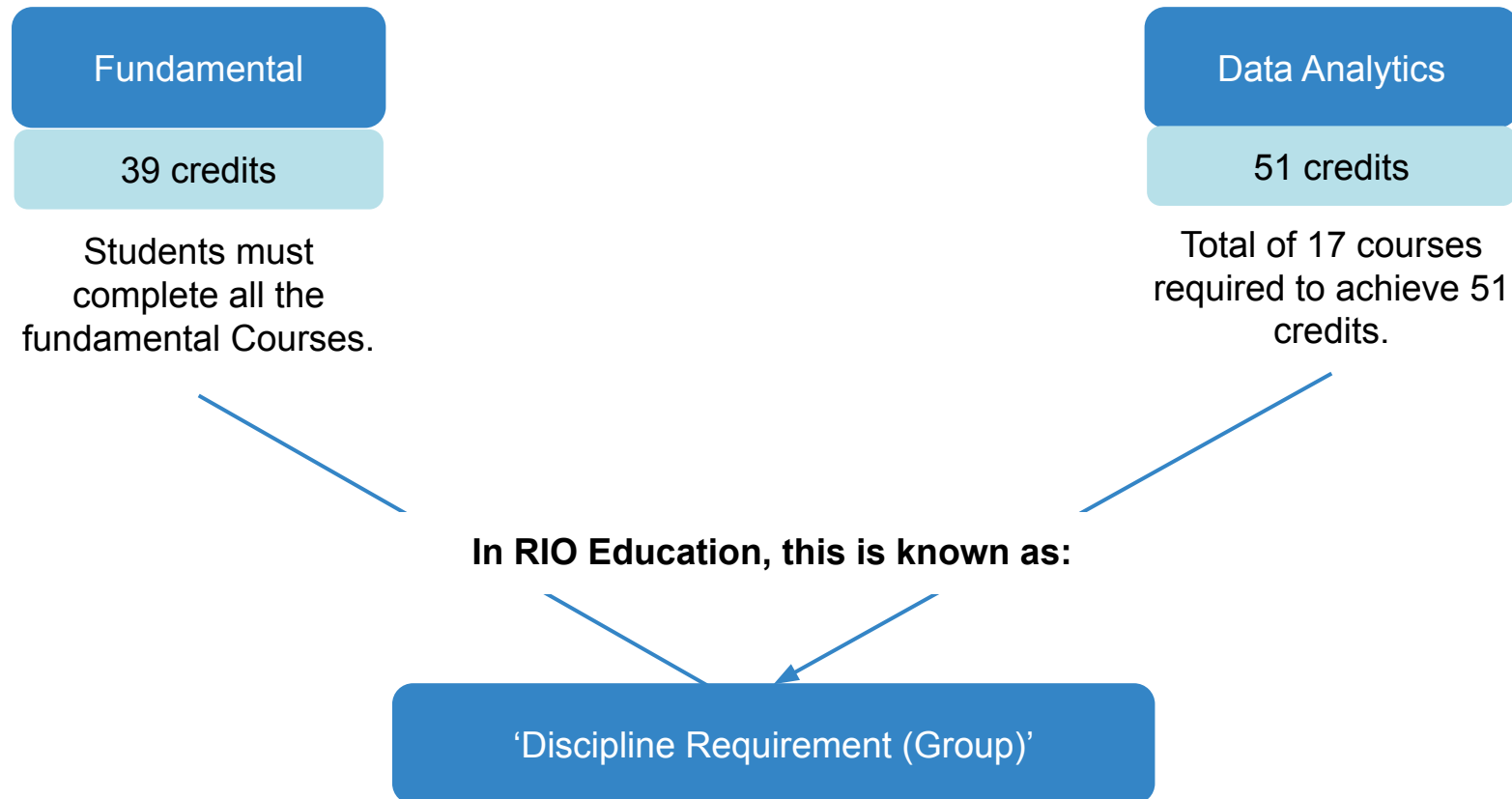
As an example, for a program like a [Bachelor of Business Information System](#), there may be a series of majors and minors that the student can opt for. A student Fred can enroll in Bachelor of Business Information Systems majoring in Business Analytics.



# Program Administration (Discipline)

So, what are the requirements of the disciplines?

Back to [Bachelor of Business Information Systems](#), there are a series of disciplines that are being offered. Each of the disciplines have their requirements to fulfill. As an example, 90 credits are required for Business Analytic major.

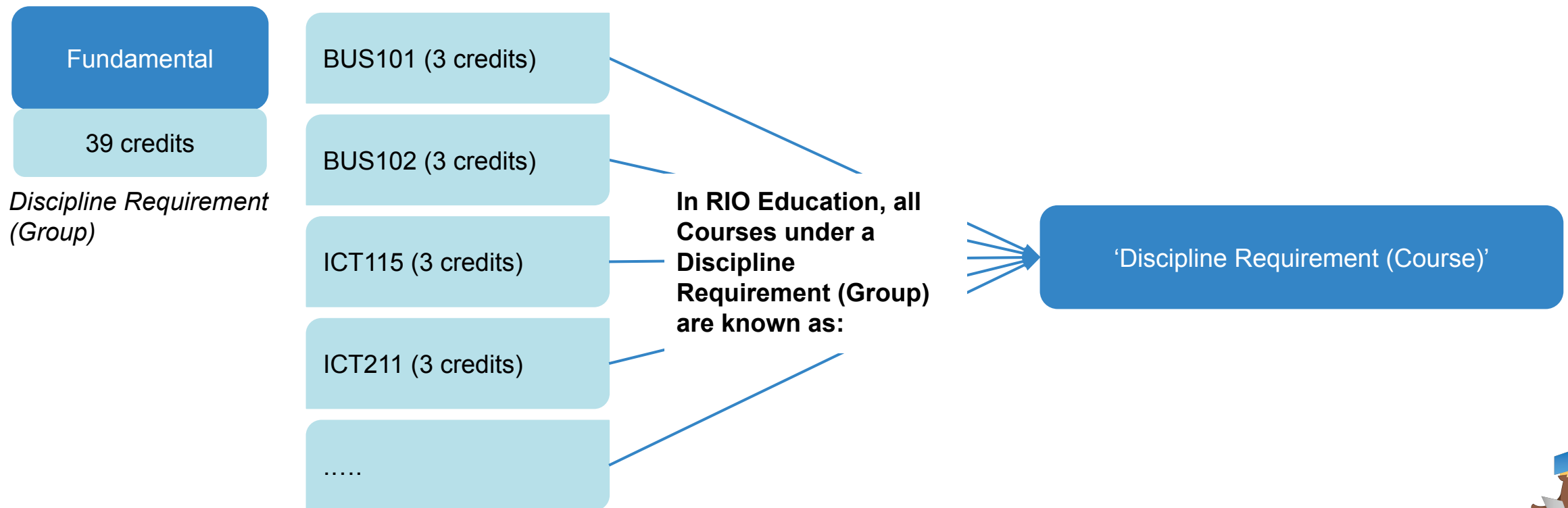




# Program Administration (Discipline)

The Discipline Requirement (Course) in RIO Education comes from the courses that you have set as Plan Requirement (Course) of the main program [Bachelor of Business Information Systems](#).

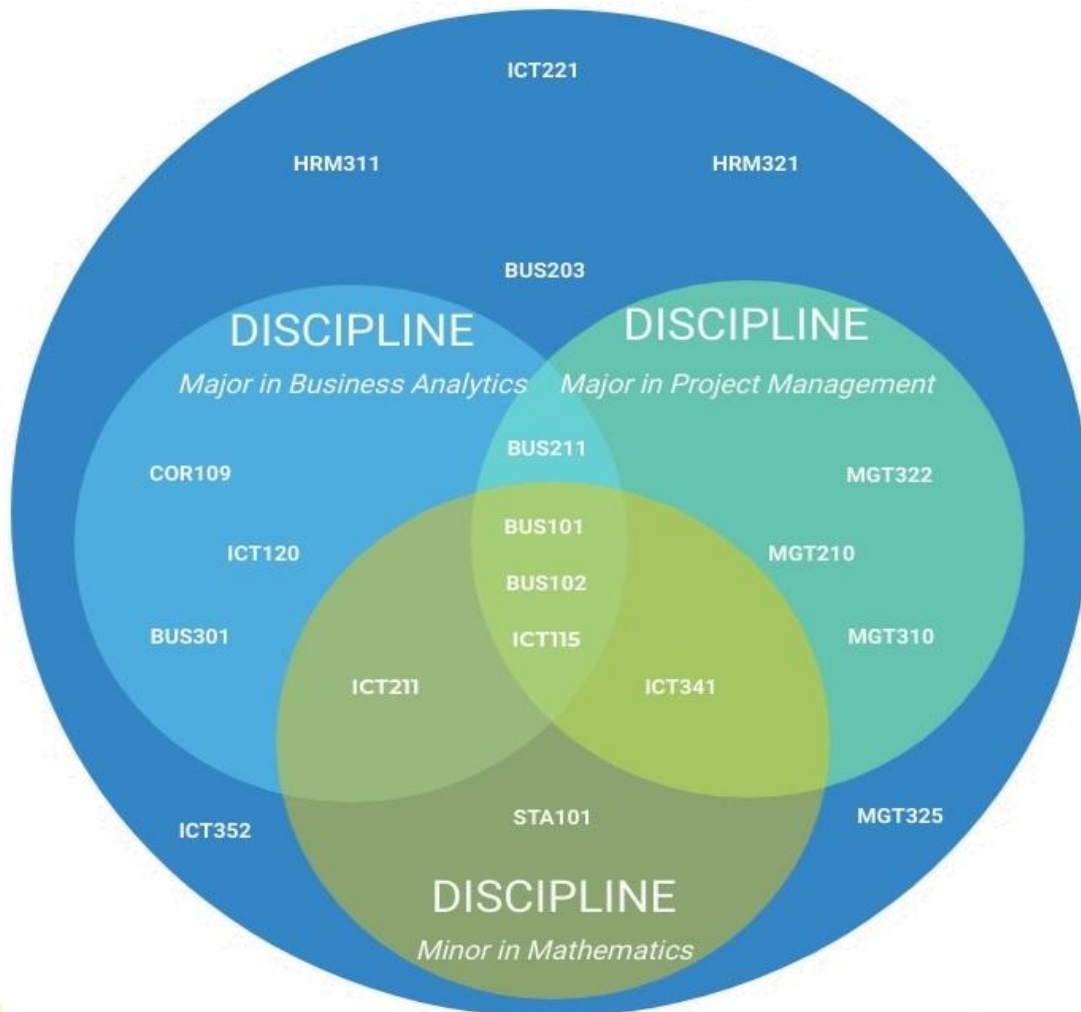
As an example, in order to fulfill the Business Analytic major, you will need to complete BUS102 in “Fundamental”. BUS102 is one of the Plan Requirement (Course) of [Bachelor of Business Information Systems](#) under “Core”.



# Program Administration (Discipline)

## PROGRAM STRUCTURE

*Bachelor of Business Information Systems*



## BUS102

is a plan requirement (Course) of the program.  
is also the Discipline Requirement (Course) for Business Analytics (Major), Project Management (Major) and Mathematics (Minor) of the program.

## BUS211

is a plan requirement (Course) of the program.  
is also the Discipline Requirement (Course) for Business Analytics (Major) and Project Management (Major) of the program.

## BUS301

is a plan requirement (Course) of the program.  
is also the Discipline Requirement (Course) for Business Analytics (Major) of the program.

## BUS203

is a plan requirement (Course) of the program.  
is not part of any Discipline Requirement (Course) of the program.
